About WLI

Education is the most important factor in empowering women. If women's empowerment in the true sense is ever to be realized, it could be only through education. Education brings prosperity not only to the woman and her family but also to the nation.

Without education, women's empowerment is a distant dream and there is no way Sustainable Development Goals can be achieved.

IITM has made considerable progress in improving the number of women students/ faculty & creating opportunities for success. IIT Madras launched the 'Women Leading IITM' (WLI) program on March -08th 2021 to boost women's leadership in science and technology. Launched in 2021, Women Leading IITM is a program to Nurture, Develop and Support women's talent at IITM along with their study/professional careers. This program is being funded by an endowment from some of our US alumni with the overarching goal of achieving a more gender-balanced and nurturing campus.

The major objectives of this program



Attract/Recruit

Conduct outreach programs to visit other institutes to get the word out and recruit women post-doc, visiting women faculty, as well as full-time women faculty. Any other proposal to increase woman faculty recruitment will also be considered, Special focus will be on departments with lower women faculty numbers

Secure

Run programs that provide physical and emotional safety for women

Develop/Promote

Create opportunities for women faculty and Postdoctoral Fellowship to do interdisciplinary work that can yield international research recognition Ex:
Responsible Al work for non-Computer Science faculty at Robert Bosch Centre for Data Science and Artificial Intelligence (RBC DSAI)

Nurture

Support admin to deliver a new/ better mentorship program for women faculty as well as to encourage leadership amongst women faculty (HoDs, Chairpersons, Deans, Director)

Support

Ameliorate hurdles to career growth for a woman faculty member Example: a grant to pay for smallchild travel while attending a conference, or a grant to provide for better child care while at work (for children up to age 5).

On International Women's Day (March 8, 2021) the first set of grantees was announced in a virtual event attended by over 225 people.
